Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Ohio Department of Health requires that all students entering the 7th and 12th grade receive updated meningococcal and tetanus vaccines.

If you have a student entering 7th grade, he/she is required to have received the following immunizations prior to the start of the new school year:

- Four or more doses of DTap
- **One dose of Tdap; 1st does given prior to 7th grade**
- Three or more doses of Polio
- Two doses of MMR
- Three doses of Hepatitis B
- Two doses of Varicella
- **One dose of Meningococcal: 1st dose given prior to 7th grade**

If you have a student entering 12th grade, he/she is required the additional immunization prior to the start of the new school:

- Second meningococcal dose. If, the initial meningococcal dose was administered on or after the 16th birthday, only one dose is required.

Your child's primary care provider may offer these vaccines. You may also contact the following locations to receive the required immunizations:

- **Van Wert County Health Department.** Please call 419-238-0808 Ext 103 or 107 M-F 8am-4:30pm to schedule an appointment.
- **Van Wert Wal-Mart Pharmacy.** No appointment necessary. M-F 9am-9pm, Saturday 9am-7pm and Sunday 10am-6pm. Please call 419-238-5928 to see if your child will require a prescription from their physician per state law.
- **Van Wert CVS Pharmacy.** No appointment necessary. M-F 8am-9pm. Saturday 9am-6pm and Sunday 10-6pm. Please call 419-238-2483 to see if your child will require a prescription from their physician per state law.

Different locations accept different/limited insurances and self-payment, please ask before scheduling. Please get these immunization requirements completed as soon as possible.
